To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas William Frame of La Porte County, Indiana,  
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte  
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Frame  
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
the Lots numbered one and two, (of Tractem North of the Indian Boundary Line) of Section thirty  
three, in Township thirty seven, North, of Range six, West, in the District of Indiana subject to sale  
at La Porte, Indiana, containing Ninety Seven acres, and ninety hundredths of an acre  
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
chased by the said William Frame

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the  
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William  
Frame and to his heirs the said tract above described:

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said  
William Frame and to his heirs and assigns forever.
