To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Saeb Waggoner* of *Elkhart County, Indiana* has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *La Porte* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Saeb Waggoner* according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 21st of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for *the West half of the South West quarter of section twenty six in Township thirty six North of Range five, East of the second Meridian, in the District of lands subject to sale at La Porte Indiana containing eighty acres* according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Saeb Waggoner*.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Saeb Waggoner* and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Saeb Waggoner* and *his* heirs and assigns forever.
