To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Orson Pattle, of La Porte County, Indiana,
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte,
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Orson Pattle
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the North half of the North East quarter of Section one, in Township thirty six
North, of Range five, West of the Second Meridian, in the District of Indiana subject
to Sales at La Porte, Indiana, containing one hundred and eleven acres and eleven hundredths of
an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Orson Pattle.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Orson
Pattle, and to his heirs the said tract above described:

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said
Orson Pattle, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
