To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Levi Price Jones of the Coole County Indiana,  
 has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at the Date,  
 whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Levi Price Jones  
 according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for  
 the 4<sup>th</sup> east half of the south west quarter of Section nineteen, in Township thirty five,  
 North, of Range five West of the Second Meridian, in the District of lands subject to  
 sale at the Coole, Indiana containing eighty one acres and ninety three hundred and ten acres  
 according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
 chased by the said Levi Price Jones

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the  
 several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Levi  
 Price Jones

and to his heirs, the said tract above described.

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said  
 Levi Price Jones  
 and to his heirs and assigns forever.
