To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas John Beat Steinbergen and George W. Allen, Assignees of John Walker,
have deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at La Porte,
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Walker,
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the South half of the North East quarter of section six, in Township thirty-four, North of Range five North of the second
Meridian, in the District of Indiana, subject to sale at La Porte Indiana, containing eighty acres,
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said John Walker.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Beat
Steinbergen and George W. Allen, and to their heirs, the said tract above described:
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said
John Beat Steinbergen and George W. Allen, and to their heirs and assigns forever
as tenants in common and not as joint tenants.
