To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Landon Rose Cabell* of *Campbell County, Virginia*, has deposited in the *General Land Office* of the *United States*, a certificate of the *Register* of the *Land Office* at *La Porte* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Landon Rose Cabell*, according to the provisions of the *Act of Congress* of the *25th* of *April*, *1820*, entitled "*An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands*," for the *East* half of the *North West* quarter of *Section* nine, in *Township* thirty four, *North*, of *Range* five, *West*, of the *second Meridian*, in the *District* of *Lands* subject to sale at *La Porte, Indiana*, containing *eighty acres*.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said *Lands*, returned to the *General Land Office* by the *Surveyor General*, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Landon Rose Cabell*

**NOW KNOW YE**, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of *Congress*, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Landon Rose Cabell* and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Landon Rose Cabell* and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *Martin Van Buren* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the *General Land Office* to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the *City* of *Washington*, the *fourteenth* day of *March* in the year of our *Lord* one thousand eight hundred and *thirty seven* and of the *Independence* of the *United States* the *Sixth* first.
