To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Landon Rose Cabell* of *Campbell County, Virginia* has deposited in the *General Land Office* of the *United States*, a certificate of the *Register of the Land Office at La Porte* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Landon Rose Cabell* according to the provisions of the act of *Congress* of the *24th of April, 1820*, entitled "*An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands*," for the *South West quarter of Section thirty in Township thirty four North of Range six West in the District of Land* subject to sale at *La Porte, Indiana*, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said *Lands*, returned to the *General Land Office* by the *Surveyor General*, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Landon Rose Cabell*

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of *Congress*, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Landon Rose Cabell* and to his heirs, the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Landon Rose Cabell* and to his heirs and assigns forever.
