To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Ruth Worthington of Washtenaw County, Michigan Territory,  
 has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Laporte  
 whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Ruth Worthington  
 according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
 the East half of the South West quarter, of Section twenty eight, in Township Thirtieth Seven, North  
 of Range five West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Laporte Indiana,  
 containing Eighty Acres,  
 according to the official plan of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
 chased by the said Ruth Worthington.

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the  
 several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Ruth  
 Worthington and to her heirs, the said tract above described:  
 To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said  
 Ruth Worthington and to her heirs and assigns forever.

 affixed.
