James Sullivan Castle according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

Fractional North West quarter of Section Three, The North East quarter of Section Twenty five and the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section Fifteen in Township Thirty seven North of Range Five West in the District of Lands subject to sale at La Porte Indiana containing in all Two hundred and Sixty acres and Fifty Eight hundredths of an acre -

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tracts have been purchased by the said James Sullivan Castle

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said James Sullivan Castle

and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said James

Sullivan Castle and to his heirs and assigns forever.
