To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

**WHEREAS** David Burr, and Ingraham Gould, of LaPorte, County, Indiana,

have deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at LaPorte, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said David Burr, and Ingraham Gould,

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North East quarter of the North East quarter, and the East half of the South East quarter, of Section eight, and the West half of the South West quarter, of Section nine, in Township thirty five, North, of Range six West, in the District of lands subject to sale at LaPorte, Indiana, containing two hundred acres.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said David Burr, and Ingraham Gould:

**NOW KNOW YE**, That the

**United States of America**, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said David Burr, and Ingraham Gould,

and to their heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said David Burr, and Ingraham Gould,

and to their heirs and assigns forever, as tenants in common, (and not) as joint tenants.
