WHEREAS Isaac Thompson Canby, of Montgomery County, Indiana,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Saporle

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Isaac Thompson Canby,

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the North half of Section thirty, in Township thirty seven North, of Range four West, of the fractional North East quarter, the South West quarter, and the West half of the South East quarter, of Section ~~thirteen~~ three, in Township thirty seven North, of Range five West, in the District of lands subject to sale at Saporle, Indiana, containing six hundred and ninety nine acres, and seventeen hundredths of an acre.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Isaac Thompson Canby.

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Isaac Thompson Canby,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Isaac Thompson Canby,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
