the South West quarter, of Section seven, the North West quarter of the South East quarter, of Section nine, and the North East quarter, of the North West quarter, of Section ten, in Township thirty seven North, of Range five West, in the District of lands subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana, containing one hundred and fifty acres.

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Peter Barton,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
