To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS Horace Burr, of Laporte County, Indiana,

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at Laporte where by it appears that full payment has been made by the said Horace Burr

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the West half of the South West quarter of Section nineteen, the West half of the North West quarter and West half of the South West quarter of Section twenty eight, the West half of the North West quarter and West half of the South West quarter of Section thirty, in Township thirty four North, of Range four West, and the East half of the North East quarter, the West half, and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section twenty five, in Township thirty four North, of Range five West, in the District of lands subject to sale at Laporte, Indiana, containing in all, six hundred and nine acres, and eighty six hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said Horace Burr,

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said Horace Burr,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Horace Burr

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
