**To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:**

**WHEREAS** Israel Thompson Canby of Montgomery County, Indiana,

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at La Porte

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Israel Thompson Canby

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the South Eastquarter of Section seven; the South half of Section eight; the West half; the North Eastquarter of the South Westquarter; and the East half of the North Eastquarter of Section nine; the West half of the South Westquarter of Section ten; the West half; and the North Eastquarter of the North Westquarter of Section seventeen; and the East half of the North Eastquarter of Section eighteen, in Township thirty seven North, of Range five West, in the District of lands subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana, containing nine hundred and fifty acres, and fifty hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR**

**GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said Israel Thompson Canby

**NOW KNOW YE**, That the

**United States of America**, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said Israel Thompson Canby

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Israel

Thompson Canby

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
