the East Half of the South West quarter of Section fourteen, and the North East quarter of Section, twenty three, in Township thirty seven, North of Range five West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at La Porte Indiana containing Two hundred and forty acres.

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *Gilman Henry*

and to *his* heirs, the said tracts above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Gilman Henry*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
