has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *La Porte*

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Adam Smith Campbell

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

*the West half of the ^{South West} ~~South East~~ quarter of Section twenty
two in Township thirty five North, of Range five West
of the second Meridian, in the District of Land sub-
ject to sale at La Porte Indiana containing eighty
acres*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR**

GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Adam Smith Campbell*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *Thomas Burnes Campbell*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Thomas Burnes Campbell*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
