To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS *Heail Bates of Kalamazoo County Michigan*

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Minamiae* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Heail Bates according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the South half of the South East quarter, of Section thirty four, in township thirty four North, of Range Seven West, of the second principal meridian in the districts of lands subject to sale at *Minamiae Indiana*, containing *eighty Acres*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Heail Bates*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *Heail Bates*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Heail Bates*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
