WHEREAS *Cornelius Blachly* of *Porter County*

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at *Minamaca* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Cornelius Blachly according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the *West* half of the *South West* quarter of *Section* *fourteen*, in *township* *thirty five* *North*, of *range* *seven West*, of the *second* *principal meridian*, in the *district* of *lands* *subject to sale* at *Minamaca Indiana*, containing *Eighty Acres*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR-GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Cornelius Blachly*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said *Cornelius Blachly*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Cornelius Blachly* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
