To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS *Barnhart Knoutz of Porter County Indiana*

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Winamac* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Barnhart Knoutz according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North West quarter of the North East quarter of section Eight in Township Thirtythree North, of Range Five West of the Second principal Meridian, in the District of lands subject to sale at *Winamac, Indiana,* containing *Forty Acres,*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract *has* been purchased by the said *Barnhart Knoutz*

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *Barnhart Knoutz*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Barnhart Knoutz*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *James K Polk* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
