Whereas William C. Pimney and Granville M. Ballard of Marion County, Indiana,

have deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Indianapolis, Indiana, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William C. Pimney and Granville M. Ballard,

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South East quarter of the North East quarter or Lot numbered two, of section thirty six, in Township thirty three North of Range six West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Indianapolis, Indiana, containing thirty acres and thirty hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said William C. Pimney and Granville M. Ballard,

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said William C. Pimney and Granville M. Ballard,

and to their heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said William C. Pimney and Granville M. Ballard and to their heirs and assigns forever.
