Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 12,769 for 160 acres, issued in favor of Ezra Hart, Private in Captain Smith's company Second Regiment United States Infantry Florida War

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North West quarter of Section Eleven in Townships Thirty-Six of Range Seven West in the District of Lands subject to Sale at Winamac Indiana containing One Hundred and Sixty acres

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Jane Ruzer and to her

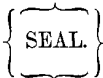
heirs and assigns forever.
