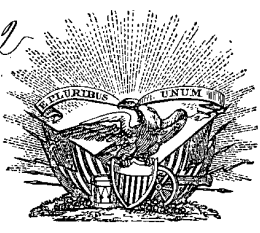

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850,

entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. *9713* for *80* acres,

issued in favor of *Cyler McWhorter Private in Captain Conrings Company, Ohio Militia War of 1812*

*See Certificate of Survey of 10th March 1853*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the

*West half of the South West quarter of Section twenty six in Township thirty six of Range seven West for the district of Lands subject to sale at Winamac Indiana containing seventy acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: *Such has been signed into Chancy Wheeler*

Now know Ye That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

*Chancy Wheeler*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Chancy Wheeler and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
